

## Adding a Note with a specific Author value

When adding a Note against a record, you will sometimes want to specify a specific Note Author in your REST call. If you do not specify a Note Author, the default value of the API User making the call will be applied to the Note.

The Note Author field is recognized by the *commentingPerson* field in REST and is represented by the Bullhorn User's UserID.

## How To Obtain a User's ID

You can search for Bullhorn Users by the Primary Email Address associated to the user, or by their first and last name. This is done by making a GET Query to the CorporateUser entity:

```
query/CorporateUser?where=email='email@address.com'&fields=*&BhRestToken={BhRestToken}
```

OR

```
query/CorporateUser?where=firstName='John' AND  
lastName='Smith'&fields=*&BhRestToken={BhRestToken}
```

The resulting API Response will include the "id" value in the response header:

```

}
```
